## Climate policy alignment

We aim to advocate for alignment of policy positions with our industry associations, in particular climate change and the goals in the Paris Agreement. We support the Paris Agreement's goal to limit the rise in global average temperature to well below two degrees Celsius above pre-industrial levels and pursue efforts to limit it further to 1.5 degrees Celsius. Aligning with associations that prioritise sustainability creates opportunities for collective action that will drive meaningful change towards a low-carbon economy. In the instance that a misalignment of positions is identified, we will initiate direct engagement with the leadership of that association.

## Our current memberships

In FY24 we held memberships with 11 associations with a total financial commitment of approximately \$346,236. These memberships are listed in the table below. Annual reviews are conducted to identify material additions or changes to policy positions of associations. The 2024 review identified two associations were in alignment, six with no current public positions, and three with non-material differences. We are engaging with the associations identified to have non-material differences to advocate for stronger alignment with our climate position.
